



Ian Cooke, M.D.

Ian Cooke held the Chair of Obstetrics and Gynaecology at the University of Sheffield, in Sheffield, United Kingdom, from 1972 until 2000 and during that time he combined laboratory reproductive endocrine research with clinical gynaecology and infertility in particular. He has worked with the World Health Organisation for many years, was an inaugural member of the Human Fertilisation and Embryology Authority in London, and Chairman and later President of the British Fertility Society. He is Director of Education of the International Federation of Fertility Societies, its WHO-accredited Liaison Officer with WHO; he chairs the Education Committee, being responsible for its programme of educational workshops, 40 of which have been organised in low resource countries in the last 8 years. He is a co-editor of the triennial IFFS Surveillance (2010), [a Worldwide Compendium of National Rules and Regulations for Assisted Reproductive Technologies](#). He is CEO of the Low Cost IVF Foundation and is working on a low-cost IVF programme with WHO, IFFS and ESHRE, being the Co-ordinator of the Training and Information Cluster in the ESHRE Special Task Force on Infertility and Developing Countries.
