



## Shehua Shen M.D., ELD (ABB)

### **Associate Professor Director of Embryology Laboratory**

Dr. Shen is an Associate Professor in Department of Obstetrics, Gynecology and Reproductive Sciences of University of California, San Francisco (UCSF). After obtaining her medical degree from Second Military Medical University in Shanghai, she worked with *In Vitro* Fertilization (IVF) programs at Women and Infants Hospital of Rhode Island/Brown University, Brigham and Women's Hospital/Harvard Medical School, and University of Washington. She has been the Director of Embryology Laboratory at UCSF since 2000, was the President of Northern California Association for Reproductive Biologists from 2007 to 2009, and currently is the secretary of Chinese Special interest group at American Society for Reproductive Medicine (ASRM) and the treasure of Global Chinese Association of Reproductive Medicine (GCARM). She has extensive experience in IVF laboratory advancements. She was amongst the team to establish intracytoplasmic sperm injection (ICSI) procedure at Brown and succeed the first ICSI baby in Rhode Island. She has consulted both nationally and internationally in the areas of Assisted Reproductive Technologies (ART). Her research focuses on improving IVF techniques, embryo culture, non-invasive embryo selection, and pregnancy outcomes. She has been an active member of American Society of Reproductive Medicine (ASRM) and American Association of Bioanalysts (AAB).
